RESEARCH AND CONTINUING EDUCATION GRANT APPLICATION

The Society's Research and Continuing Education Grant was established to support the professional development of Winterthur conservation and material culture alumni who are active members of the Society. Funds may be used to help defray costs for attending meetings, seminars, and workshops, or to conduct research or develop special projects. The amount available from the fund is approximately \$1,200 per year. Funds may be divided among qualified applicants.

CRITERIA FOR REVIEW

- · Applicants must be current members of the Society
- Usefulness of project or continuing education program to the applicant and/or the conservation or material culture field
- · Qualifications of applicant to conduct project or attend the continuing education program
- · Ability of applicant to disseminate outcomes of project (publication, teaching, presentations, etc.)
- · Appropriateness of budget for proposed project

PROCEDURES

The application deadline is May 1 and November 1 of each year. The applications will be reviewed by a panel of three members of the Society and a recommendation will be made to the Society's board for final approval. Notification of awards will be made as soon as possible. Research or continuing education travel should be scheduled two to twelve months after the application deadline.

FINAL REPORT

Due within 60 days of completion of the project or continuing education program. Final reports should be sent to grants@sowf.org. Reports may be published in part or in full by the Society, including posting on the Society's website or distributed through its social media platforms.

Application Process

- 2. Solicit a letter of support from a colleague
